Revival Nights



Soul Care

Over the 2 Soul Care weekends offered, 120 people joined in and learned what it is to surrender our baggage to Jesus, embrace the Kingdom life He's always wanted us to live and experience deliverance!

Women's Ministry

It is our desire for all women to experience a more intimate relationship with Jesus and grow in their confidence of who they are in Christ. We want to inspire women to embrace their passions and be strong leaders—to change the world by influencing their world, wherever that may be. Throughout the year, women of Kingdom City meet for worship, connecting events, and Bible/Book Studies.

This year we had a few craft nights (we love our crafts!), a fall Potluck Brunch and a one day retreat called "*Delight*" where 115 women enjoyed an amazing charcuterie lunch and heard from our special guest, Pastor Jennifer Mitchell, from Lighthouse Church in Stony Plain. She shared her personal story of how she went from being a victim of war, to shaping hearts with the love and delight of Jesus. The attendees also enjoyed a time of hearing some practical tips from a fashion stylist, Effie Asante, with advice on clothing styles for different shapes and sizes, along with advice on building a wardrobe on a budget.







Kingdom City Youth

It has been an incredible year of pursuing God and encountering his presence in youth ministry! Over the last year we have had the opportunity to have over 530 youth in our building, welcoming anywhere from 100 to 150 students from grade 6 to 12 on a weekly basis during our regular Tuesday programming, seeing many commit their lives to Christ. In March Kingdom City hosted Airdrie's very first Citywide Youth Rally that had 380 students which included 16 other Christian organizations/churches. It was a night to remember as we gathered together to worship, have fun and dive into the Word of God. In June, Kingdom City Youth hosted a remarkable event by inviting Christian rapper Hulvey from Atlanta, Georgia as a special guest. This marked a significant milestone for our church, as we had never previously organized a concert of this magnitude. However, thanks to the dedicated leadership of the youth ministry and the support of over 40 volunteers, we successfully welcomed attendees from across the province for an unforgettable evening.

Another highlight included our two retreats with our junior high and senior high students. During these weekends, students temporarily disconnected from the usual distractions of their daily lives, dedicating their time to the pursuit of becoming true disciples of Jesus.

Our Youth are actively embracing Kingdom City's vision of Releasing the Kingdom of heaven here on Earth through the upcoming generation.



Kingdom Kids



We are excited for all God is doing in our Kingdom Kids ministry. While undergoing significant changes in recent years, and despite our ongoing search for a permanent pastor, we've successfully implemented staffing positions to maintain consistency across all programs.

Kingdom Kids continues to welcome new faces regularly. On average, we receive 100 kids each Sunday, with at least one or two new families joining us weekly. An encouraging story involves a family visiting for the first time, where their initially nervous daughters left at the end of the morning expressing how much fun they had and eagerly anticipating their return next week.

Our vibrant new curriculum, Wonderlnk, reintroduces a structured morning with Bible stories, age-specific small groups, crafts, memory verses, and consistently instills four key values in the kids: "I am Known by God," "I am Loved by Jesus," "I am Led by the Holy Spirit," and "I am a child of God." We believe in empowering our Kingdom Kids through the Word, enabling them to impact their spheres of influence confidently and boldly. It's thrilling to witness kids being anointed, trained, and equipped in their spiritual gifts.

Additionally, Kingdom Kids and Youth have collaborated to revive our Grades 5/6 ministry. This involves kids joining worship in the main sanctuary and then going into their own time together of learning Biblical truths, ensuring their engagement and interest during the transition between Kingdom City Kids and Kingdom City Youth. The collaboration between the two groups is creating a dynamic and enriching experience for all involved.






Young Adults

We have one of the most vibrant Young Adult communities in the Calgary area! Kingdom City Young Adults (ages 18-30) are hungry for the presence of God and set a lot of the culture inside and outside of the church as kingdom leaders. This is where young adults come to get grafted into the family of God, seek the Lord, change the world around them, and walk in their calling. Our Young Adults held various nights of deep worship, fun activities like laser tag, serve days, and interactive study nights at different homes. Our Young Adults make up the majority of people serving in many parts of the church body and are catalyzed to use their gifts.

It is a great place to make new friendships and a place to feel welcome, no matter if they are new to faith or a seasoned believer! From Spring 2023 to Fall 2023 the group has doubled in overall attendance with at least 30 Young Adults attending regularly.



Kingdom Classics

This year saw the launch of our Senior Adults ministry, also known as "Kingdom Classics" and the first year was a huge success. They have become a very active group with a core group that meets for activities twice a week, every week. Every Thursday morning a group meets for exercise followed by a coffee time at Cross Iron Mills Mall. Thursday afternoon the Classics gather for a Bible Study where 16 -20 people meet for a great study and discussion time. They have held other activities throughout the year including: a movie night, a games night, a summer BBQ in the park where they were joined by another one of Airdrie's Senior Adult Groups. The highlight of each month has been their Potluck Events where they always have a lot of fun and opportunities for relationship building. The potluck events usually average between 40 to 50 people, with the largest event being around 100 when we joined with the Young Adults. They look forward to another successful year with plans to involve more of our senior adults in activities where they can be a ministry in serving other people.

We celebrate all that God has done through the Church family connecting events that we held this year!


July 30 – "Ice Cream Sunday"




Welcome Nights

City Impact

We want our city, region, and the world to know God's Kingdom is for them. This happens by being His hands and feet and sharing His message using our Spirit-given gifts and abilities. We want people everywhere to know Jesus, and it starts in our own community. We believe it's important to intentionally love those we "bump elbows with" on a regular basis or throughout the year.

We held a Serve Day on March 25th where we had 67 people registered, that participated in 7 various projects including crocheting/knitting, visiting with seniors, working with the food bank or handing out coffee downtown Calgary.

"The goals were to serve the City in practical ways through volunteer hours, raising awareness, and being present. We wanted to find organizations and groups that we could come alongside in support of. Most of these organizations meet the first-hand needs of people in the City. With our motivation being service, and helping the poor, the widow, the outcast, and oppressed, we helped all around the City. With our partnerships, we tackled food insecurity, people living in homelessness/addiction, elderly folks living fairly isolated, broken families, families in need, and people who do not regularly experience love and care from others. God always multiplies. Through people's willingness to serve, He used their work as steps of living out their faith. I think a few things to celebrate is Kingdom City showed we want to serve with our time, money, love, and energy. 


Canada Day Summer Festival

We wanted to bless the people of Airdrie and interact with them, revealing the heart of Jesus to them through generosity and community. What better way to meet the people of our community than holding a Summer Festival right in the location that they have to drive or walk past to enjoy other Canada Day activities that are happening within our city?! We handed out over 1000 hotdogs, hundreds of bags of cotton candy, painted numerous faces, had bouncy castles, games and a food truck right in the front parking lot of Kingdom City. AND for the first time Kingdom City Church participated in the Canada Day Parade by entering a float – 20 of our Kingdom City people walked 2km alongside of the float before joining the rest of the church and community at Kingdom City!

Airdrie Fest

For the 2nd year, we had a booth at AirdrieFest in September. Volunteers & Staff manned the Kingdom City booth at this city event, where we had Plinko & Facepainting. We handed out hundreds of prizes from Kingdom City sunglasses to candy & coffee. Our smiling team was there to answer questions about who we are as a church, the different ministries that we offer and just to interact with our community.



Packages for Hope - Christmas Project

This year, Kingdom City sought out to make a Christ-like impact on our City and Congregation by providing Packages For Hope. One thing is for certain, our church is extraordinarily generous! These packages included everything from basic needs, like food and baby supplies, to personalized gifts for individuals in the families, gift cards for groceries and gas, personal encouragement cards, and prayer backing. Our church partnered with the Airdrie Pregnancy Centre, the Airdrie First Club, and families within our congregation to provide hope to those in need this Christmas season. Because of Kingdom City's generosity, we were able to make an immense impact, blessing 86 individuals that made up 25 families around Airdrie. Through Kingdom City's generosity through physical gifts and donations to the compassion fund, an estimated \$12,500 was given towards blessing these families. Over 205 toiletry and home items, 100 food items, and 75 boxes of wrapping supplies/ornaments were given. These packages contained 85 gifts cards that ranged from \$50-\$100, over 300 gifts and toys, and massive amounts of baby supplies for families who needed them.

Advance Quebec

Kingdom City desires to spread the Gospel throughout our entire nation. Recognizing God's guidance, we understand that strategically expanding our missional efforts to the Province of Quebec is crucial. Over the past few years, we've formed a partnership with Hannah & Joël Dumaine of Génération Unité, working collaboratively to bring the message of the Kingdom to Quebec. Our Directors of Advance Quebec, Brent & Merrilee Schartner, along with others, have journeyed there to advance our partnership and vision. We firmly believe that Quebec plays a pivotal role in unlocking a nationwide revival and harvest for Jesus in Canada, and we are enthusiastic about our ongoing efforts in this regard.

S.E.A. Team

In December 2019, Kingdom City signed our first formal partnership, a threeyear Seamless Link Agreement with a group working together in Southeast Asia. It helped our local church-family to understand and personalize the ministry of the C&MA on a global scale. Through this SLA, Kingdom City was able to be involved in seeing social justice, compassion care, health care, trauma service, gospel presentations, English as a Second Language (ESL) services, or other services provided to the Rohingya people.

Over the past 3 years, Kingdom City has donated \$20,000 for the refugee/relief work to the Rohingya people in Malaysia through the Alliance International workers there as a fulfillment of our three-year commitment to reach & bless these people. As of July 31, 2023, our partnership has drawn to a close, however we continue to pray for the International Workers who are continuing their work in Malaysia and for the Rohingya people to experience the goodness & kindness of God.

We will continue to seek out further opportunities for Kingdom City to partner with globally!

Change The World City Care



This past year we also introduced "City Care" whose purpose was to provide specialized professional services on behalf of Kingdom City, to enable us to enhance and strengthen our social & spiritual impact in the Airdrie Region. This includes offering resources for people in Kingdom City and other regional churches but also accessible to the greater public beyond the church.

Be-YOU-tiful - Teen Body Image Support Group

This 6-week support group was a safe place to process & bring hope to teen girls who struggle with body image. There were 14-17 teen girls who participated in this group that focused on experiencing freedom through a holistic view of self: to encompass body, mind, and spirit.

Human Trafficking Awareness Night

Life Set Free Holistic Counseling (Sandra Kliewer) & Freedom 8848 held an event sponsored by Kingdom City at the Town and Country Centre in April that brought awareness and education that Airdrie and Calgary are the fastest growing places for Human Trafficking in Canada. Approximately 100 people came to hear more from these organizations, local politicians, police officers and those who are involved in the fight against sex trafficking through prevention, rescuing victims, and restoring survivors.

Moms Matter

MomsMatter is a new initiative sponsored by the Airdrie Pregnancy Care Centre and hosted by Kingdom City Church. It began meeting in September, with the goal to create a space offering education and support where moms can find connection and a community of peers. Every month they have brought in local experts who can speak with experience and wisdom about the journey of motherhood. Currently there are about 15 women who meet a couple times per month, including 5 volunteers from Kingdom City. The group is seeing growing relationships, women opening up and being vulnerable with the safe space we have created. As this group continues this next year, please continue to show support through prayer, or dropping off snacks OR connect with us if you have specific experiences you would like to share!
